Geneva Red Wings Baseball

The Geneva Red Wings are a member of the New York Collegiate Baseball League which was founded in 1978. The NYCBL is a summer wood bat development league for professional baseball. Major League Baseball funds a portion of the league's operational costs. The league gives college players who have not yet signed a professional contract the opportunity to develop their skills at a higher level of play, gain experience with wood bats, and be evaluated by scouts. The Geneva Red Wings' roster is made up of top collegiate players from around the country, from as far away as Florida, Texas and California. Each player has the ability to be drafted by a Major League franchise in the future, and their skills will be evaluated while playing in Geneva.

Overview of Camp Program

The Red Wings Baseball Camps are set up to give players of all ability and talent levels a chance to learn the game from professional coaches. Players will be instructed in small group settings, according to ages. Players will learn the skills of the game through repetition and drill work. The goal of the coaching staff is for each participant to leave each camp session a better player and more enthusiastic about baseball.

Refreshments and Spectators

Cold beverages will be sold throughout the camp sessions. Spectators are welcome to attend the camps to watch the workouts. For safety reasons, visitors are requested to stay out of the playing areas. Please direct all questions to Coach Ross Trachtenberg during camp sessions.

Saturday Swings with the Wings

- ☞ Players will be grouped by age for the one hour session.
- ☞ Players will work through various hitting drills to improve their swing by working off of the batting tee, doing soft-toss drills and batting cage work.
- ☞ Players who come for multiple sessions can work to improve their swing week to week.

Game Day Workouts

Players will practice all areas of the game during the workout:

- ☞ Hitting
- ☞ Base Running
- ☞ Fielding Mechanics
- ☞ Position Play
- ☞ Pitcher and Catcher Drills

Players will work out for two hours at McDonough Park before a Red Wings Home Game.
